


A Christmas party is planned for December 20, at which time, gifts will be exchanged and secret pals revealed. It is always a special time.








### **Treesbank Community Church**

With greetings of Merry Christmas, we pray the wonder of the birth of Christ will never fade. Mary and Joseph had gone through the ordeal of traveling to Bethlehem to be counted in a census. With no rooms available they sought shelter in a stable to prepare for the birth of the son of God. While they were watching their flocks at night just like every other night, an angel appeared to the shepherds.

Luke 2:10-15, <sup>10</sup> But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people.<sup>11</sup> Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. <sup>12</sup> This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."<sup>13</sup> Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying,<sup>14</sup> "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favour rests. <sup>15</sup> When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."

This story is told and retold each year. How God guided and directed each character in this story is amazing. An angel spoke to Mary and Joseph and they did as they were told to do. An angel gave great news to the shepherds. But they were not told to go to find the child. They were only told that they would find the child in a manger, which they did, and they praised God. That scene continues to play out in this world today. Not the same story, but a story with the same basis. A person has heard the message that God loves them. Jesus died for them. They are touched to the heart. The person then rushes to find out more about this Saviour Jesus Christ. Finding that God's Word is true, they worship and give praise to God because of what Jesus has done for them.
