Elizabeth Anne Wilson
October 20, 1935 - March 10, 2024



With deep sorrow, we announce the passing of Elizabeth (Betty) Anne Wilson, aged 88. Betty was born in Lena, Manitoba, growing up in a farming family with her parents and twin brother Robert (Bob). Out of school, Betty trained in the secretarial / administrative field, and as a young woman, she met the love of her life, Dahl Wilson, in the Thornhill, Manitoba area; they married in 1955. The family moved their farming operation, lock, stock and barrel, to Wawanesa in 1959. 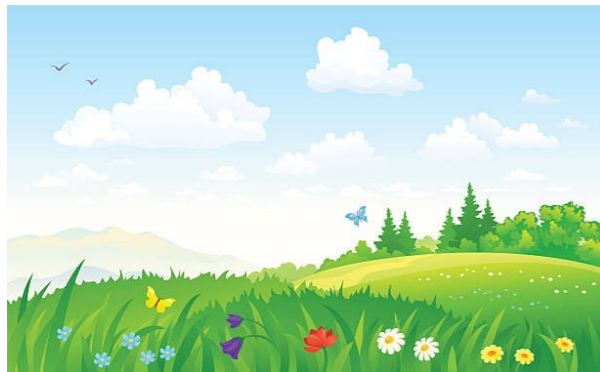


Treesbank Community Church
